

# What In-Person Instruction Looks Like on the First Day

## ARRIVAL TO SCHOOL:

- ★ Arrival is between 7:50am-8:20am and school begins at 8:20am. **DO NOT** drop students off or let them arrive prior to 7:50am.
- ★ All students (TK-8th) are required to wear a mask or face shield with a hood. Please wear your face covering while walking to school. If dropped off, face coverings should be on prior to exiting the vehicle.
- ★ Due to health screenings, back gates will be locked at ALL times
- ★ Check map for grade level specific health screening checkpoint
- ★ Primary parents are encouraged to park and wait with their child in health screening line while adapting to new protocols
- ★ Parents need to wear a face covering when out of their vehicle
- ★ There will be staff to walk children to class from the checkpoints, but if your child needs additional assistance, the parent/guardian may walk the child to class for **ONLY** the first week of school. Parents/guardians will need to leave children at the door and are not permitted inside the classroom. No congregating in the hallways.
- ★ Breakfast will be served in the classroom

**If your child has any of the following symptoms, please keep them home until symptoms are gone for 24 hours. If symptoms continue, contact your healthcare professional for further guidance.**

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Loss of taste
- Loss of smell
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Muscle ache
- No appetite
- Headache
- Abdominal pain
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting

## **DISMISSAL FROM SCHOOL:**

- ★ Check schedules for *NEW* dismissal times.
- ★ Pick up times slightly vary by grade level. Teachers will walk students out to the front of school to meet parents. Parents will not be allowed to wait outside classroom doors or to congregate in front of school.
- ★ Please keep facial coverings on until home or inside vehicle
- ★ All students exit school through the front gates
- ★ “Grab and go” lunch will be delivered to each classroom at the end of the school day and taken home with students
- ★ Students going to the After School Program will eat their lunch there. The After School Program will also remain in grade cohorts. After School closes AT 5:00pm

## **THINGS YOU CAN DISCUSS WITH YOUR CHILD(REN) NOW:**

- ★ Facial coverings will be required for ALL students (unless exempt by doctor’s note)
- ★ There will be breaks outside throughout the day where students can take their facial coverings off. Please remind your children that during these breaks they need to keep a safe distance from others.
- ★ Recess will be only with their own class. Playground equipment will be available, but not able to be shared unless cleaned before next use. No equipment may be brought from home at this time
- ★ Toys and personal items need to be left at home at this time
- ★ Review your drop off and pick up schedule as well as the map that shows the direction in which your child should walk to class
- ★ All students will practice a sanitize in and sanitize out method for each room
- ★ Remind your child they will go directly to class after screening. The cafeteria and playground are closed in the morning
- ★ Bring extra snacks as there will be an opportunity for snack time during the day. If you are unable to provide a snack, one will be provided
- ★ There will be opportunities for your child to go outside and use an outdoor learning space. Please remind them that even when outside it is still a learning environment.
